Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you for your ongoing support this week, and in particular for supporting your children to engage so well with their live lessons and remote learning. Regarding our plans for tomorrow, the school will now be closed due to continued extreme weather conditions and the extended red weather warning. However, we are able to operate the Year 10 Physics exam tomorrow morning which will still take place as scheduled.

## Year 10 Physics Exam

- **Physics Exam:** The morning Physics exam will go ahead as planned. We have been closely monitoring the temperature in the Exam Hall. Due to the large space and high ceilings, the hall remains cooler, and the temperature tomorrow morning will not impede the exam.
- **Timings:** Students are expected on site by 8.25am and should go directly to the Main Hall. The exam will be 1hr 15m in length and students will be dismissed to return home directly after this exam. Students will not have live lessons for the remainder of the day but should engage with revision resources on Google Classroom to prepare for next week's rescheduled exams. Students will receive an email with next week's revised exam timetable from Mr Bellamy and Mrs Threader.
- **Uniform:** Students attending for the exam should wear their school PE kit to remain as comfortable as possible.

Thank you again for your ongoing understanding, flexibility, and support as we balance our students' education and exams with their wellbeing during this period of exceptional weather. From Monday, 29th June, temperatures are forecast to drop significantly. The Collegiate will be open as usual, and we will return to our standard full school uniform expectations.
